- **Entry fee - \$10.00 per animal.**
- **Exhibit entry required by August 3, 2017.**
- **Limit two animals per exhibitor, per lot. Any class with less than three exhibitors and five animals will be combined.**
- **Jackpot-type show with 100% payback.**
- **NO BREED SHOWS. All breeds compete together.**
- **Livestock Health Requirements for public exhibition (see summary of state rules).**
- **ALL exhibits must be pre-entered. NO day of entries will be permitted. Animals must be in place one hour before start of show on the day of the show and will be released following the show. Pen space is on a first come, first served basis. All others will be permitted to show out of their trailers, in designated area.**

## Beef Belles Leather Fashion Show

1. The object of this class is two-fold; fashion parade of exhibitors and well-behaved halter-led beef. Contestants will be judged on modern fashionable attire, which must be attractive and lend style to the class. The garment must be made of leather, suede, or other beef by-products. NO synthetic (man-made) leather or suede may be used.
2. Beef must be conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter.
3. All rules for exhibiting beef at the Morrison County Fair shall govern.
4. Matching accessories for the animal are highly encouraged.
5. Contestants do not need to make their outfits.
6. Animal does NOT need to be owned by fashion contest exhibitor.

- Class 1 Junior Beef Belles, 10 years and younger

- Class 2 Senior Beef Belles, 11-18 years
- Class 3 Adult Beef Belles, 19 years and over
