FFA Activities

1. One entry may be made in each class by an individual living in Morrison County and enrolled in vocational agricultural classes during the 2015-2016 school year, including 7th and 8th graders.
2. Only animals which are projects and on which records are kept as certified by their FFA advisor can be exhibited in FFA classes.
3. Exhibits must be registered in advance. FFA registration forms are due August 4, 2016.
4. All animal and non-animal exhibits must remain on exhibit at the Morrison County Fairgrounds for the entire fair showing. Early removal of an exhibit will result in forfeiture of any premium earned. All exhibits will be released at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 16.
5. All livestock and poultry exhibited must meet the requirements of the Minnesota Health Board of Animal Health. All livestock must pass inspection of the official Fair Veterinarian.
6. FFA livestock may be entered in open classes if animals are eligible.

Morrison County Fair Chapter Trophy

Morrison County Agricultural Society will present a traveling trophy to the FFA Chapter with the highest accumulated placing. Both individual and team placings will be considered. Winning chapter will claim the trophy until next year's Morrison County Fair.
